



How Do I Know What **Zone** I am In?

Zones	Description
Estill 1	Estill-1 is in the western part of the county. Communities included are: Rice Station, Witt Springs, Sandhill, Winston, western part of the City of Irvine, and the northern portion of Wisemantown.
Estill 2	Estill-2 is in the northwestern part of the county. Communities included are: Fox, Hargett, Palmer, part of Spout Springs, and the Northwest portion of the City of Irvine.
Estill 3	Estill-3 is in the southwestern part of the county. Communities included are: Red Lick, Station Camp, South Irvine, Combs, and the southern part of Wisemantown.
Estill 4	Estill-4 is in the northern and central part of the county. Communities included are: Ravenna and the majority of the City of Irvine.
Estill 5	Estill-5 is in the northern part of the county. Communities included are: Hardwick, eastern part of Hargett and the northern part of the City of Irvine.
Estill 6	Estill-6 is in the eastern part of the county. Communities included are: Fitchburg, Pitts, the eastern part of Wagersville and the western part of Drip Rock.
