- 4. Entries must be removed between 9:30 and 11:00 A.M. on Saturday morning, July 7th.
- 5. Prize money may be picked up Saturday morning between 9:30-11:00 a.m.
 - 6. If removed before, prize money will be forfeited.
- 7. The Danish System of judging will be used with top entry in each designated. Danish System Blue Ribbon worth 3X, Red Ribbon worth 2X and White Ribbon worth 1X.
- 8. No 4-H exhibitor or parents of 4-H exhibitor will be allowed in the exhibit hall during judging of 4-H exhibits.
