### **RULES:**

1. ALL 4-H non-perishable entries will be accepted on Monday between 10:00 A.M.- 6:00 P.M. and all items will be accepted on Tuesday between 9:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M.
2. All entries will be judged on Tuesday afternoon starting at 4:00 P.M.
3. Only entries listed in the fair book will be accepted and all entries must have been completed during the year (since the last county fair).
4. Entries must be removed between 9:30 and 11:00 A.M. on Saturday morning, July 7th.
5. Prize money may be picked up Saturday morning between 9:30-11:00 a.m.
6. If removed before, prize money will be forfeited.
7. The Danish System of judging will be used with top entry in each designated. Danish System - Blue Ribbon worth 3X, Red Ribbon worth 2X and White Ribbon worth 1X.
8. **No 4-H exhibitor or parents of 4-H exhibitor will be allowed in the exhibit hall during judging of 4-H exhibits.**
9. **THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL!**
10. Age Groups for Arts & Crafts Classes:  
Cloverbuds - school age-age 8  
Jr. 4-H - Ages 9-13  
Sr. 4-H - Ages 14-18
11. Any class with an asterisk (\*) on the left hand side is eligible to go on to the Kentucky State Fair.
12. 4-H members may bring only one (1) entry for each category. (Ex. 1 plate of biscuits)
13. Must be original work of 4-H member.
