Rules:

• Entries and cancellations must be made 3 classes ahead. Three or fewer entries, paybacks start at 2nd place money. Show Management may choose to cancel any class with only one entry.

Regular classes:

• KMSHA/SMHA Open classes are open to horses of any sex or age registered with Kentucky Mountain Saddle Horse As-

JT - Juvenile Trained:

• The JT or Juvenile Trained class is for the juvenile that has ridden and trained their horse without adult help or assistance. The horse cannot have been trained or ridden by an adult for 170 days (just short of 6 months). The juvenile and parent will be asked to sign a statement of understanding showing that they know exactly what the rules are for this class.

• If the class is offered as an Open Performance Class it will be judged on the horse that is doing the best, most consistent gait from its' chosen division (horses from all 3 divisions excluding park horses are welcome in the Open Performance Class.)

Semi Pro:

• Semi Pro is for the person that is not paid to train horses. This person may work at a barn, sell horses, or even board horses and as long as they are not paid to train they are eligible. To be eligible for this championship you must have shown in

a class of that division, any trail class for the Semi Pro Trail Championship and any Classic Class for the Semi Pro Classic Championship.

Championship Classes:

To be eligible for a Championship class a horse must compete in a class in a division addressed by the Championship Class.

Important Information:

• All horses on show grounds must have a current Coggins and Health Certificate.

During 2013 any horse that is found to have not been transferred and ownership is incorrect or not current on the KMSHA/SMHA Registration, the horse/owner will forfeit any and all winnings or KBIF points for the season, without contest.

• Persons on federal or certified HIO suspensions or disqualifications may not transport a horse to the show grounds and may not participate in the show in any way other than as a spectator. All individuals who desire to participate in KMSHA/SMHA classes must be a member in good standing, possess a current Riders Card and be able to present documentation showing that their horse is registered and certified with KM-SHA/SMHA as defined in the rulebook.
