**Rules:**

1. The committee may combine classes if there are less than two exhibitors exhibiting less than 3 animals.
2. All 4-H exhibitors must have completed the 6 hours of livestock education and show proof.
3. Any exhibitor wishing to change classes after registration must show registration.
4. Any bull over 1-year-old must have a nose ring.
5. All animals must be halter broken and under control of the exhibitor.
6. Any breed with 10 or more head with 2 exhibitors will be given their own breed class.
7. In order for cattle to enter a breed class, animals must have registration papers; otherwise, they will be considered commercial.

**Market animals will be divided to not more than 10 per class.**

1. Lightweight Market Animal
2. Heavyweight Market Animal
3. Champion Market Animal

**Beef Show Breeds:** Angus, Charolais, Commercial (Cross Breed), Other Breeds, Polled Hereford, Salers and Simmental will be rotated alphabetically by breeds and age – females show first, followed by males

Senior Yearling Heifer - calved Sept. 1, 2012 - Dec. 31, 2012  
Champion Heifer - All 1st place winners will participate

Junior Bull Calf - calved after January 1, 2014  
Senior Bull Calf - calved Sept. 1, 2013 - Dec. 31, 2013  
Summer Yearling Bull - calved May 1, 2013 - August 31, 2013  
Junior Yearling Bull - calved Jan. 1, 2013 - April 30, 2013  
Senior Yearling Bull - calved Sept. 1, 2012 - Dec. 31, 2012  
Two Year Old Bull – calved Sept. 1, 2010 - Aug. 31, 2012  
Champion Bull - All 1st place winners will participate
