1. ALL 4-H non-perishable entries will be accepted on Monday, June 30th between 12:00 Noon -4:00 P.M. and all items will be accepted on Tuesday, July 1st between 10:00 A.M – 6:00 P.M.
2. All entries will be judged on Wednesday morning, July 2nd starting at 9:00 A.M.
3. Only entries listed in the fair book will be accepted and all entries must have been completed during the year (since the last county fair.)
4. Ages for 4-H youth is 9-18. Classes are available for Cloverbuds ages 5-8.
5. Entries must be removed between 9:30 – 11:00 A.M. on Saturday morning, July 5th.
6. Prize money may be picked up Saturday morning between 9:30-11:00 A.M. 4-Her and parent/guardian must be present.
7. If removed before, prize money will be forfeited.
8. The Danish System of judging will be used with top entry in each designated. Danish System – Blue Ribbon worth 3X, Red Ribbon worth 2X and White Ribbon worth 1X.

9. No 4-H exhibitor or parents of 4-H exhibitor will be allowed in the exhibit hall during judging of 4-H exhibits.
10. THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL!
11. Age Groups for Arts & Crafts classes:
 - Cloverbuds – Ages 5-8 • Jr. 4-H – Ages 9-13 • Sr. 4-H – Ages 14-18
12. Any class with an asterisk (*) on the left hand side is eligible to go on to the Kentucky State Fair.
13. 4-H members may bring only one (1) entry for each category. (Ex. 1 plate of biscuits).
14. Must be original work of 4-H member excluding classes 100-112.
15. Estill County 4-H, Estill County Extension Service and the Estill County Fair Board will not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
16. Cloverbud classes receives no money – only participation ribbons.
17. 4-H BLUE RIBBON AWARD – One (1) overall winner will receive \$50. This award will include blue ribbons won by only 4-H members ages 9-18 living at home in one household during the 2014 Estill County Fair. Entries will be taken on Saturday morning while checking out exhibits.
