*293. Senior Weaving – One item (only one item permitted for entry); rug, belt, stool with woven seat, or wall hanging item made through various weaving techniques using mixed media fibers, no plastic materials allowed. Wall hanging must be mounted and ready for hanging. Baskets are not included.

294. Cloverbud Weaving – Any item that has been created through using weaving as a technique. Any material allowed. Wall hanging must be mounted and be ready for hanging.

BASKET CRAFTS – Natural materials, any size, shape or design. Non-natural materials may be woven into design.
