Irvine Police and Estill Sheriff activity report

IPD Officer Jason Conrad served an Estill County arrest warrant January 8 on **Jimmy Fowler**, 38, of Dark Hollow Road, Irvine for failure to appear in court.

During a search, Conrad stated that he located a yellow baggie containing 0.3 grams of a crystal like substance that field tested positive for methamphetamine.

Fowler was charged with possession of a controlled substance, first offense and first degree (methamphetamine).

An Estill County arrest warrant was served January 5 on **Johnathan Roberts**, 32, of Laurel Street, Irvine by IPD Officer Dalton Cambell. It was for non-payment of court costs, fees, or fines.

Calvin Jones, 50, homeless, was arrested January 5 by Officer Conrad on an Estill County warrant for failure to appear.

Chief John Sturniolo charged **Jaylah Shaye Harrison**, 24, Riddle Court, Irvine, with operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol, first offense on January 2.

An Attempt to Locate (ATL) was issued for a newer white Chevy with red tags for driving recklessly.

The chief stated that he located the vehicle on the bypass. The citation states that he noticed a strong odor of alcohol when the window was rolled down.

The citation adds that the driver was asked three times to exit the vehicle and had to be forcefully removed. She also refused to perform FSTs.

The driver, was transported to the Irvine Police Department where she was given an intoxilyzer test. The citation states that it registered .231.

Sgt. Sam Hensley assisted with the investigation.

Donea Vaughn, 31, of Broadway, Irvine was charged January 6 by Officer Campbell with violation of a KY EPO/DVO.

The citation states that she made contact with her ex-husband at the Dollar General on Winchester Road at 1:22 p.m. She was arrested at 9:01 p.m.

The citation adds that her presence in the Dollar General was observed on video surveillance.

On January 8, Deputy Josh King received a call of a man laying in the parking lot at Rose's Cash & Carry.

Deputy King responded, along with Irvine police officers and Trooper Gross.

They found a male walking unsteadily on Richmond Road and requested EMS. The man

refused to go to the hospital.

The citation states that Trooper Gross assisted Deputy King with putting the man in the patrol car because he was resisting arrest.

Deputy King charged **Larry Gene Patrick Jr.**, 35, of Lexington with public intoxication of a controlled substance (excludes alcohol), and resisting arrest.

James Bradley Tipton, 51, of Elm Street, Ravenna was arrested January 7 by Deputy Jim Marshall.

According to the citation, Tipton is homeless,

and the deputy was responding to a call from his mother's residence at 7 a.m.

When he arrived, the deputy said he called for EMS to transport Tipton to Marcum & Wallace Hospital where he was treated and released.

The deputy said he was notified by the hospital that no one would pick Tipton up when he was released.

Deputy Marshall stated he received another call that Tipton was in a backyard and throwing stuff over into an alley way.

This time, Tipton was arrested. He was charged

with public intoxication of a controlled substance (excludes alcohol) and disorderly conduct for throwing the wood into the roadway from a trash-pile.

Wendy Turner, 40, of Winchester was served by Deputy Marshall with a Laurel County District Court warrant on January 9.

The warrant says that Turner failed to appear Nov. 9 for public intoxication of a controlled substance, disorderly conduct, 2nd degree, resisting arrest, and drug paraphernalia - buy-possess.
